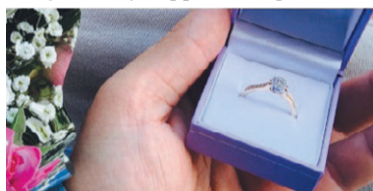

# Local wins Crookwell Quick Shear

CROOKWELL Golf Club held another successful Quick Shear competition on Saturday November 21. This year the event seen over 50 shearers compete from the local district, across Australia, New Zealand and Canada. There was also three female shearers. The day was made possible once again by the continued sponsorship from Divall's Earthmoving and Bulk Haulage, and supporting sponsor Goulburn Farm Machinery and also a contingent of local businesses. These included Crookwell IGA, Davies Newsagency, Southern Highlands Chiropractic, Crookwell Hire, SMR Chartered Accountants, Meats A Treat, Spackman Motors, Hills Butchery and Harts Pharmacy. Without this generous support the quick shear would simply not be possible.

On the day we seen fine, sunny weather. The crowd was treated to an entertaining show with fast, quality shearing. Each shorn sheep is inspected by three judges who each give a red or green light. A green light indicates a shed quality shear. For a shearer to compete in the next round they'd need at least two green lights from the judges.

The Veterans class was won by Young resident Gene Mills in 33.33 seconds, 2nd Ashley Gilbert 42.08 and 3rd Dayne Haynes 48.70.

The Novice event was very well supported with 16 entries and we saw an excellent display of talent from our young learner shearers. This class was taken out by local Adam Laverty, 2nd Sam Picker, 3rd Angela Collins and 4th Joe Offley.

The Intermediate grade was hotly contested with the final six shearers all shearing their sheep in under 52 seconds. The winner was

Matthew Black from Boorowa in 45.26 seconds, 2nd Kyle Richens (Young) 46.11, 3rd Ray Meredith (Taralga) 48.18, 4th Rowdy Carr (Goulburn) 48.85, 5th Shaun Fajnor (Canada) 50.08 and 6th Kurt Layton (Bundarra) 51.29.

In the Open's we saw some excellent shearing with all 17 competitors shearing under 50 seconds. The judges were under pressure and the shearing times were quick. The need to be clean to get the required green lights meant there was only a fine line for errors. The top six shearers in the semi-final had shorn their sheep in under 41 seconds.

A Calcutta was held before the Open final. Spectators were able to buy their shearer in an auction. The six shearers were highly sort after with the pool reaching an impressive \$4220. Eighty percent of this pool would go to the winning bid-

der(s) and 20% (\$844) will be donated to the Crookwell Community Trust.

The crowd was divided in their favouritism between Rod Sutton the current New Zealand champion and world record holder for shearing a tally of 839 sheep in a nine hour day and dual Crookwell Quick Shear winner local lad DJ Hape. These two did not disappoint going into the final as the fastest. Danny Knight, Terry Garnham, Josh Knight and Josh Mills made up the top six. Rod Sutton was fastest but unfortunately he received three red lights and was disqualified. But this left the way for local Terry Garnham. Terry was only 1.2 seconds behind but shore clean with three green lights to take out the event.

1st Terry Garnham (Crookwell) 34.88, 2nd Danny Knight

(Crookwell) 38.18, 3rd Josh Mills (Young) 39.16, 4th Josh Knight (Crookwell) 40.88. Both Rod Sutton and DJ Hape were disqualified.

The Golf Club and Quick Shear organising committee would like to thank the shearers and crowd for their participation. A special thanks going to all the volunteers who worked extremely hard behind the scenes before, during and after the day. Commentators Brad Dawson and Ashley Gilbert were once again a stand out. The event would not have been possible without the valuable support of the sponsors, the work of all the volunteers and support of our local community.
