Community Projects Update

Corangamite Shire: There are 15 projects that have been funded by the Berrybank 1 Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund, which are being managed by the Shire Council. We are pleased to announce that the Lismore Public Art Installation, Corangamite Energy Efficiency Program—Phase 1 and the Camperdown Botanic Gardens Projects are all complete. The Darlington Mechanics Hall, Terang Lake, Lismore Creek, Skipton Recreation Reserve, Bradvale Hall, Glenormiston South Hall, Northern Towns Tourism, Camperdown Theatre and Corangamite Energy Efficiency Program—Phase 2 Projects are all currently underway. The Skipton Public Art Installation, Derrinallum Recreation Reserve and Lismore Swimming Pool Projects are due to commence in 2021.

Golden Plains Shire: There are 4 projects that have been funded by the Berrybank 1 Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund, which are being managed by the Shire Council. We are pleased to announce that the Teesdale Turtle Bend, Golden Plains Economic Development, Tourism & Investment Strategy and Three Trails Projects are currently under way and the Streetscape Improvement Projects are due to begin in 2021.

Construction Update

Wind Turbine Generators

On Friday 10th July, Berrybank 1 Wind Farm hit another milestone in receiving our last delivery of components for the Wind Turbine Generators from Keppel Prince in Portland, Victoria.

The installation and crane crews have been working hard over the past month to now having completed all the pre-installation works on the 43 turbines and have now also completed the main installation of a further 10 turbines bringing the total of completed main installations to 26 out of the 43 Wind Turbine Generators.

On-site & Off-site Substation

Both of the Substations are progressing very well and are currently 90% complete. The civil works are nearing completion with the placement of blue metal and the finishing of drainage works. Pre-commissioning works are continuing on both Substations. The installation of the new lattice transmission tower and OPGW cable that connects the wind farm substation into the 220kv Ballarat-Terang transmission line is now complete.
